How the Lord Used Us in November, 2022

Happy Thanksgiving!

Thank you for your prayers and sacrificial financial support of our ministry for Christ. Cathy and I are so grateful for your partnership with us, and we pray for God’s blessings on you and your family!

We had a slow month in November with no M.A.D. Live Events on the calendar. However, we continue to minister one-on-one with Divine appointments, and wherever God opens the doors for us to serve Him in any way. On page 3 of this report is a cool testimony of what I was involved in this past Friday night. Check it out!



I did a Walk thru the Bible Classic Old Testament seminar at our home church in November and we had 61 people attend. This is a fun event where we cover the 17 Old Testament history books in chronological order. We learn 77 major people, places, events, and the geography of the Old Testament with hand motions (called kinetic learning) and we recite all 77 people, places, and events with hand motions in less than 3 minutes when we’re done! Amazing! The Old Testament comes to life and is understood by those participating.

Our church has a food pantry ministry twice a month, and I shared a Gospel message with everyone who came. People sign in and then they are moved into the sanctuary where I share the Gospel with each group of people. It ends up being 5-6 presentations each food pantry night to different groups. No one receives food without hearing about the Bread of Life! We have been blessed to see many people saved at the outreach as we tell them of forgiveness of sins and everlasting life through Christ. Glory to God! We fed 59 families at the first food pantry in November and 107 families at the second one. All of these people had the Gospel seeds planted in their hearts so the Holy Spirit can use it for God’s glory.

Also, I participated in four Zoom evangelism equipping meetings with people who are serious about getting better at sharing Christ with the lost people in their world and want to make sharing a lifestyle. If you are interested in starting one, please let me know and I’ll be happy to facilitate it!

To let you know about our ministry truck situation, we have a rebuilt engine on order. We were told it would take 4-5 weeks to receive it. It will come with a 5-year, 100,000-mile warranty. We had 9 events in October, and we really missed having it for the extended trips we had to make during that month. It has been difficult not having the use of it, but with the exception of October, we’re grateful it happened during a normally slow time of the year. THANK YOU to those who have contributed to help us pay for the unexpected \$21,650 bill to replace the engine.

Our son-in-law, Mike, continues to improve and gain strength. Mike is scheduled to see the Orthopedic surgeon on the 28th to see if he can start putting weight on his left leg. Lord willing, that will be the next

milestone in his journey. His colostomy bag will remain in place until he sees the surgeon in February. Assuming he is satisfied with the healing, they will schedule Mike to have the intestinal reconnective surgery in March. Continued prayers are appreciated!

We received an email that said that our local Texas Roadhouse was doing a fundraiser for the Special Olympics and that State Police Officers would be serving the tables...(Tips for Cops). Their tips would go to support the Special Olympics....JACKPOT! In 2017, Ron and I were on our way to Utah for our annual adventure trip. We stopped at a Texas Roadhouse in Wyoming that was doing the same fundraiser. We got to share the Gospel with 3 State officers, one of which was the Superintendent of the Highway Patrol for all of Wyoming.

Tonight, I stocked up on literature, and off we went. Upon arriving, 3 State Police Officers brought rolls to tables as guests arrived. Cathy took her seat and I made my way to each of the officers, told them of my police background, and gave each a Police Gospel card. I told each of them that if they could find the time, I'd like to pray for them. After I sat down, all 3 officers came to my table together to be prayed for! I stood up, wrapped my arms around the 3 of them as best I could and prayed for their safety and salvation. They each thanked me and went back to work.

Across the aisle from me, and behind Cathy in the next booth were 2 Viet Nam veterans. I took out 2 pieces of Gospel literature and wrote a thank you note to each of the men and gave the literature to them while thanking them for their service. After reading the tract, the veteran in the booth behind Cathy got up, came over, and thanked me for the tract. We got a server named Jake tonight, and I shared the Gospel with him and we prayed for him.

After dinner, we got up to leave, and the veteran in the booth behind Cathy stopped me and asked me to pray for their safety as they travel back to NC after dinner. So I stopped and prayed for them. As we were exiting the building I stopped and spoke with the State Police Sergeant, and showed him a photo of my Indian motorcycle with the thin blue line flag on the saddlebags. He commented on the bike and said, "Let me show you mine." He opened his phone and showed me a photo of his TN Highway Patrol Harley-Davidson! This is guy is a motor officer!
